

Overview of Presentation Types

<u>Panel Presentation (60 minutes)</u>: These are formal, thematic presentations. The discussion is intended to be interactive with audience participation strongly encouraged. Some panels feature presentations that were submitted individually and later grouped by conference organizers based on shared themes.

<u>Technical Workshop (60 minutes)</u>: Participants have an opportunity to learn about new skills or a very specific technical aspect. Although attendees will not become proficient in any skills, the workshop should include concrete exercises that directly engage workshop attendees in learning about the topic.

<u>Roundtable (60 minutes)</u>: Participants have an opportunity to engage in an interactive discussion about a specific topic. Presentations should address the following component: (1) brief informal overview of the topic, (2) interactive discussion.

<u>Poster Presentation (two 60-minute sessions)</u>: These presentations provide an opportunity for groups or individuals to display their program descriptions and research findings in a poster format.
